3. B-1, B-2, B-3 COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL STRUCTURES AND USES

Zoning Certificate – \$175.00 for any valuation up to and not exceeding fifty thousand (\$50,000.00) dollars plus an additional fee of one dollar (\$1.00) per thousand (\$1,000.00) dollars or fraction thereof for valuation over fifty thousand (\$50,000.00) dollars.
