**MEETING MINUTES:**

Regular Meeting – April 19, 2016

Mr. Mittas made a motion to approve and waive the reading of the minutes from the April 19, 2016 Regular Meeting. Motion seconded by Mr. Smith and voting YES – Mr. Mittas, Mr. Nichols, and Mr. Smith.

**FIRE:**
