

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF

The Canton Township Board of Trustees met in a Regular Session on

MEETING MINUTES:

Regular Meeting – October 18, 2016

Mr. Mittas made a motion to approve and waive the reading of the minutes from the October 18, 2016 Regular Meeting. Motion seconded by Mr. Smith and voting YES – Mr. Mittas, Mr. Nichols, and Mr. Smith.
