

May 7th Meeting Highlights

Fire Department

The Board approved smoke alarm testing that is a required two-year process to ensure the detectors will function properly. Silco will be conducting this at the three stations and community center. The cost is \$5,526.

Engine 22 is at Young Trucks for a possible/suspected head gasket. While this is out of service a backup will be in use.

Public Works Department

Canton Township has (3) park pavilions available for rental. Year to date Faircrest Pavilion A has been reserved 24 times, Pavilion B 3 times, and Community Park Pavilion 6 times. The rental fee for township residents is \$100 and non-residents \$150.

Asphalt Paving Bids and Chip Seal Bids were opened Tuesday. All bids will be forwarded to our legal council for review and will have contracts awarded at our next Public Meeting.

The Board approved to purchase a 2020 Freightliner 108 from ARM Truck Corp. The truck was used as a show truck for the past several years at different expos. The truck currently has below 4,000 miles and will be outfitted for snow and ice control equipment. In looking at current truck prices for a new truck would cost a minimum of \$220,000, we were able to purchase this truck for \$149,000.

Text Amendment CA-1-24 to amend the general standards and provisions in the Canton Township Zoning Resolution regarding sexually oriented businesses and adult entertainment businesses will become effective on May 16th.
