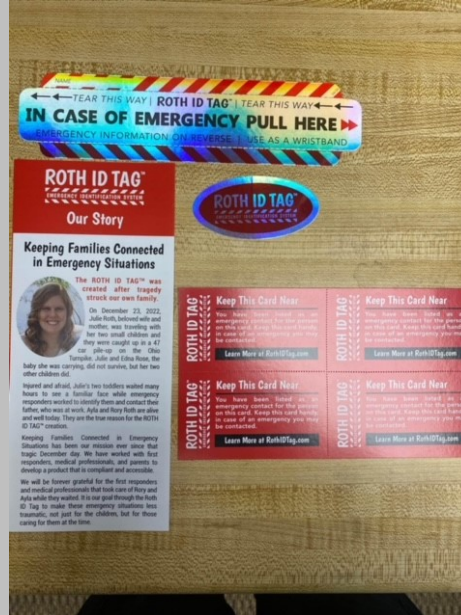

Public Works Department

An update was given that the new dump truck will be received in the next couple of weeks.

The Board approved a resolution to mark the following roads as "No Parking" from 8:00 AM- 11:00 PM for Community Day Saturday, June 22nd:

Springfield Ave SW (Faircrest and Davis), Monica Ave SW (Faircrest and Davis), Davis ST SW (Springvale and Monica), 39th ST SW (Highview to dead end)

The Board approved new cameras at Faircrest Park to enhance security.

Zoning Department

The Board declared the following properties as a nuisance as deemed by the Zoning Director, and order them abated per Ohio Revised Code 505.173 and/or 505.86 and/or 505.87.4. 512 Aultmont Ave NW, 4330 14th St NE, and 5th St SE.

The Board approved the Fiscal Officer to sign letter to Stark County Auditor requesting a lien on the tax duplicate for lawn maintenance/high grass nuisance assessment on (11) parcels 1307480, 1401320, 1312457, 1302514, 1308052, 1301591, 1304740, 1304739, 1307062 and 1307061 totaling: \$5,700.00

As of the 6/18 meeting, 153 letters have been sent for high grass nuisance notification. The township has mowed 41 properties. An assessment is then placed on the tax duplicate.
