Appeal #1219-23 Marathon Petroleum Co/ AEP

Parcel No. 10016867-Gambrinus Ave SW- B3- Commercial Business

Applicant is seeking a 23-foot variance to the rear yard setback and a 1-foot variance to the north side yard for a proposed site station in a B3- Commercial Business District. This property is located in the Southwest Quarter of Section 18 in Canton Township, Stark County, Ohio.

Mr. Bradford from Bair-Goodie contractor for AEP stated the plans include constructing a uninhabitable electric control sub station for Marathon Petroleum. The purpose of this site is for additional expansion and vehicle access.

Q: Who currently owns the property?

A: Marathon currently owns the property and AEP would purchase the property if the variance is granted.

Q: What is the area on the parcel that the substation would be located?

A: See the plot plan. There will be fencing around the substation.

Q: How high is the fencing?

A: Approximately, 7 foot of fencing with 1 foot of barb wire at the top.
