
Safety Day

Canton Township Safety Day 2022 was set for October 1st.



The Fire Department currently spends \$7,547 dollars for annual subscriptions. These subscriptions cover everything from EMS reporting, continuing education, scheduling, and modem services. Our current EMS supply budget is \$30,000 annually. These supplies consist of disposable items such as oxygen tubing, IV, bandages, PPE, and any/all items needed to treat any type of medical emergency. Transitioning to Cleveland Clinic Mercy medical control the department will save \$27,547 over the next two years. Of this saving, \$11,500 will be used to improve the departments electronic record keeping, state and federal reporting systems, inventory, scheduling, and operations tracking systems.

The Board received a draft copy of Fire Department's annual report that indicates the township responded to more calls for service in 2021 than 2020 overall with a notable increase in EMS related calls over 2020's volume.



Public Works Department

The Board approved to sign the 2021 Township Highway Mileage Certification of 97.28 miles of public roads in Canton Township.

The Board approved a resolution that spells out requirements and fees to excavate within township roadway and right of way.

Options for a resident opt-in communications call/text message technology are being explored to enhance resident awareness of items going on within the township.

Heard from Public Works a repeater antenna has failed and needs replaced at a cost of \$2,080. A temporary solution is in place to enable Public Works staff to communicate on their frequency.


