Fire Department

The Board accepted the resignation of full-time firefighter Brian Hull effective 12/6/24. The department expects to post openings for part-time and full-time positions soon.

The Board approved the application for the Assistance to Firefighter Grant.

Public Works Department

The Board approved a resolution to designate a "No Parking" zone on 4th ST SE between Marietta Ave SE and Baumford Ave SE.

The Board approved a resolution to designate temporary "Handicap Parking" on Springfield Ave SW during the Township Winterfest Event on December 7th from 4pm-11pm.

Community Park will close December 2nd and restrooms at Faircrest Park will close for the year also. Both parks will have automated closers enabling the parking lot to remain closed to vehicle traffic.

Zoning Department

The Board declared the following property as a nuisance as deemed by the Zoning Director, and order it abated per Ohio Revised Code 505.173 and/or 505.86 and/or 505.87.4. Parcel #1400143- 10th St NW for trash/ debris.

The Board of Zoning Appeals will conduct a public hearing on Tuesday, December 10th at 7pm to hear the following appeals:

Appeal #1246-24 Campbell Oil Co

Parcel# 1300674, 10003653, 10003040- Cleveland Ave SW and Faircrest ST SW- B3- Commercial Business

Applicant is requesting a twenty-three-foot (23') variance to the front yard setback for a fuel canopy structure, a thirty-six-foot (36') variance to the front yard setback for a kerosene dispenser, and a thirty-five-foot (35') variance to the south side yard for a vacuum system. This property is located in the Southeast Quarter of Section 28 in Canton Township, Stark County, Ohio.

Appeal #1247-24 Matthew Rowe

4223 13th ST NE- R2- Single Family Residential District Applicant is requesting a variance to exceed the square foot area of the primary use structure and a variance to exceed 1,200 square feet of unattached accessory buildings in a R-2 district. This property is located in the Northeast Quarter of Section 1 in Canton Township, Stark County, Ohio.

Yard Waste Update

The Residential Yard Waste site will close for the season on December 1st. The Yard Waste site operations will be closely monitored as we close out the first year of performing under a privatized model. The Board will then assess the final numbers to make determinations on future yard waste operations.

**** Current Card Holders who plan to renew for 2025 - Please keep hold of your electronic card pass, as it will be renewed once 2025 pricing is established and save the program money, by not having to replace the card. Canton Township received reimbursement amounting to \$286,986, or 87.5% of the total, as it pertains to costs to demolish and abate North Industry Elementary School. Successfully obtaining grants through collaboration with other entities, where Canton Township ARPA funds picked up the remaining 12.5% of the cost.

The Board approved the renewal of cyber security ongoing training.
